NOTICE OF PROPERTY VALUES

The Macon County Revenue Commissioner has completed the work of reviewing and adjusting assessed valuations under applicable law and hereby gives notice that the assessed valuations of all property listed for taxation have been fixed as provided by law and are available for public inspection on the Revenue Commission's website; www.maconcountyal.com and available beginning July 29, 2021.

The Macon County Board of Equalization will sit from August 30th through September 30, 2021 at the Macon County Courthouse Annex 102 N. Main St., Tuskegee, AL 36083 to consider any protests that may be filed by any taxpayer not satisfied with the valuation of their property. Any taxpayer wishing to file an appeal must do so in writing and submit it to the Secretary of the Board of Equalization, P. O. Box 830420, Tuskegee, AL 36083, by August 27, 2021. Please include your phone number.

Upon receipt the taxpayer will be contacted by phone by the County appraiser. There will be no in-person informal meetings with County appraiser. An appointment for the Board of Equalization hearing will be scheduled if a resolution is not reached in the initial discussion with the County appraiser. Appeals can be filed by calling the Macon County Revenue Commissioner's office at 334-724-2607 or 334-724-2306.
